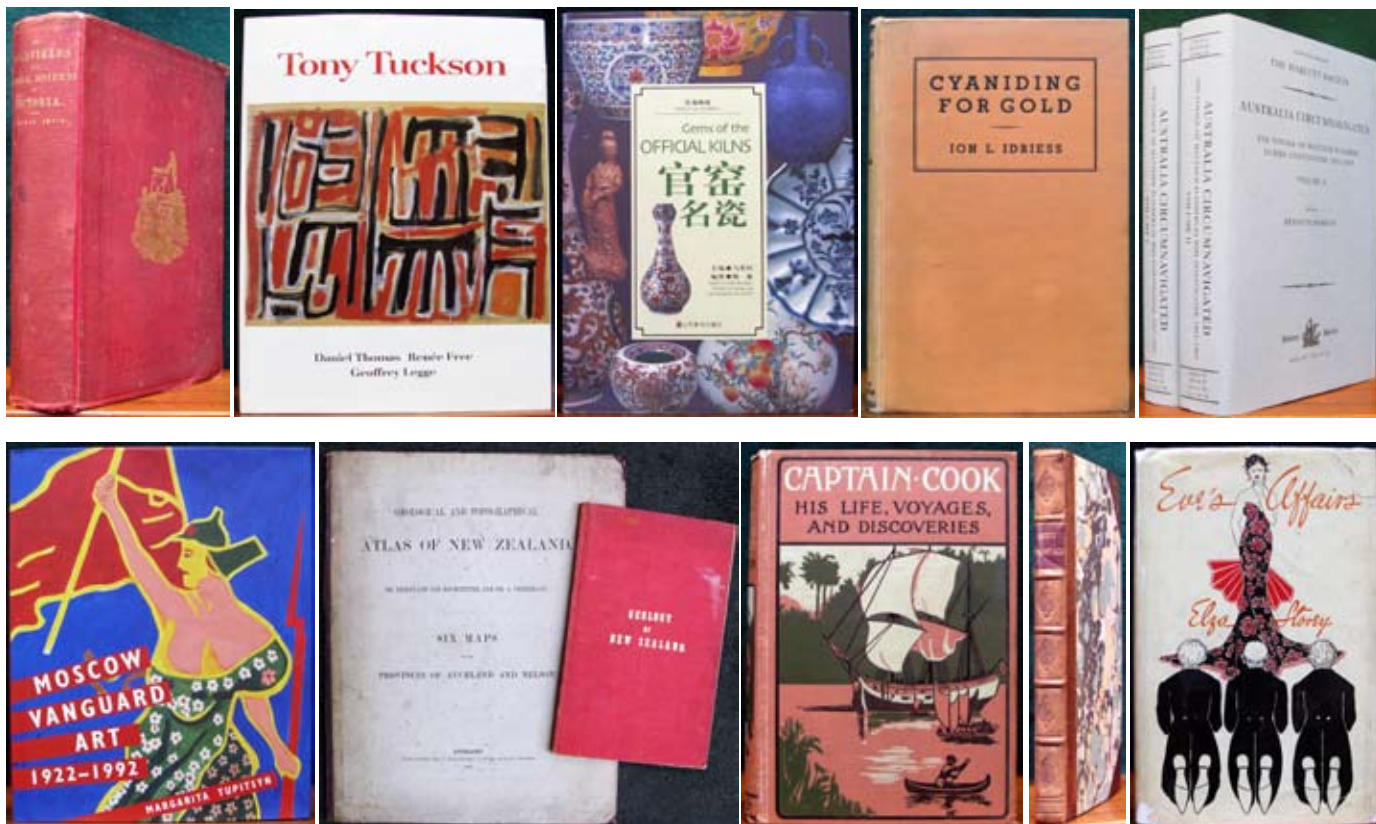

FOREWORD

I am a great admirer and sometime subscriber to *The Economist*. Their articles are wide-ranging and full of interest and it is, in my opinion, the best magazine of its type. Additionally, and this is important, their use of the English language is mostly impeccable. The Christmas double issue which I read over the Christmas break was a delight. They are focusing on "data" and its importance at the moment. Unfortunately in the Christmas issue in a Leader entitled "Les stats, c'est moi. How to think about data in 2019" it seems they couldn't decide whether the word "data" is singular or plural.

One the one hand in the first paragraph of the article we see "Data is the new oil" and yet in paragraph 4 we read "That data are valuable is increasingly understood by individuals..".

Certainly "data" is a plural word but would we use "datum" to refer to information that we think of as "data"? I wouldn't but perhaps others might. The *Wall Street Journal* says that "... singular verbs now are often used to refer to collections of information.." and it is my belief that this is now common usage. However whether singular or plural, it seems inconsistent to use both forms in a single article.

Talking about language hasn't distracted me from the point of the article. Google and Facebook makes huge amounts of money tying data to humans and we, as well as government regulators, should be wary of this. Are we aware of all the personal information we are giving freely to these tech giants? I heard only today that Facebook won't delete your account even if you die. There have to be good reasons why they won't let you go, even beyond the grave!

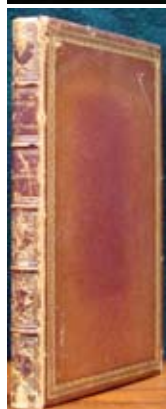
