



FOREWORD

There has been gradually increasing pressure on museums, galleries and libraries to return to their original ownership, objects collected, looted or stolen by past generations,

Last year Manchester Museum returned to the Groote Island community, 174 culturally important indigenous objects, collected in the NT by a British anthropologist in the 1950's.

The Australian National Gallery returned to India the stunningly beautiful 900 years old "Dancing Shiva" bronze statue, purchased from a now disgraced NY dealer, but earlier looted from an Indian Temple.

I saw this on show in the Gallery, quite by chance, just two days before it was removed from display to be returned to India.

Currently, Cambridge University Library is being pressured to return Scotland's oldest surviving manuscript, the "Book of the Deer", which features the oldest surviving example of written Scots Gaelic. It is a 10th century book with the gospels in Latin, but with Gaelic annotations from the 12th century in the margins.

The book has been in the library since 1715 and is believed to have been taken from the monastery of Deer in Aberdeenshire during the wars of Scottish independence in the late 13th century. It was loaned to and exhibited in Aberdeen Art Gallery in 2022, and huge crowds visited to sight it.

Perhaps the biggest issues are the Elgin Marbles, a collection of sculptures from the Athenian Acropolis, taken by the 7th Earl of Elgin in the early 19th century and now in the British Museum. Elgin stated that he removed the sculptures with permission, and a UK parliamentary inquiry in 1816 concluded that Elgin had acquired the marbles legally, but nevertheless their presence in the Museum is the subject of longstanding international controversy.

Please enjoy reading the catalogue and be assured that no item listed herein has been looted or stolen!
