




FOREWORD

A couple of newsletters I received recently were a bit like the curate's egg, ".. good in parts" but too prolix to be an enjoyable read. Skilful editing might have improved them immensely.

In this vein I think of Xavier Herbert's "Poor Fellow my Country" which some called "Poor Fellow My Reader"! I purchased and read it when it was released but it took stamina to finish. It was a huge book and a great publishing success, though I wonder how many purchasers actually read it!

Xavier's agent suggested that William Collins publish the book and this happened with a contract that stipulated no edits or cuts to the manuscript, though it would have been helped by a sympathetic editor. Beatrice Davis had been his editor at Angus & Robertson, but she had moved on and they had fallen out over a number of issues, in particular he was upset that she had sent his Jewish wife Sadie a Christmas card. Xavier was apparently difficult and I know from some A & R author acquaintances and my own experience that Beatrice could be too.

Many years ago she sold me some books but called a couple of weeks later to ask for some of them to be returned. She was most displeased when I told her that some had already been sold.

The late Walter Stone, book collector & publisher, and founder of the Book Collectors' Society of Australia was an excellent editor, something he had done for years for the Society and for his own Wentworth Press.

I had once written an article on book collecting for a magazine, and asked Walter to look at it for me. He picked up a red pencil and started reading. In thirty minutes he had cut the size by about 30%, and improved it enormously without losing any of my message. Sometimes less is more!

When I write my catalogue forewords I am constrained by the small space available and find that helpful as it stops me waffling on unnecessarily!
